James Ducharme, MD,CM, FRCPC

The UBC Department of Emergency Medicine and Division of Pediatric Emergency Medicine extend a warm welcome and thanks to our Visiting Professor for 2015 EM Research Day, Dr. James Ducharme.

Dr. Ducharme is a Clinical Professor of Medicine at McMaster University, Editor-in-Chief of the Canadian Journal of Emergency Medicine, and Vice-President of the International Federation for Emergency Medicine. He is also widely known as a regular speaker at "Emergency Medical Abstracts" conferences . Dr. Ducharme completed an EM residency in Los Angeles, and over the years that followed has held numerous major leadership positions in Canada including Program Director of the Royal College EM Residency Program at McGill University, ED Director of the Atlantic Health Sciences Corporation, and President of the Canadian Association of Emergency Physicians (CAEP).

Dr. Ducharme is internationally recognized for his research and publications on acute and chronic pain management, and has been a leader in this area for over 20 years. He led the creation of the CAEP Position Statement on Pain Management and the CAEP Guideline on Headaches. He was also co-director of the "Pain in EM" initiative, a project that examined pain management in 20 Canadian and US EDs. He collaborated on the Canadian Headache Society Guideline on Headaches and the Symposium on Pediatric Pain Research, and is co-editor of a textbook titled Pain Management and Sedation: Emergency Department Management.
